OPENING WORDS & CHALICE LIGHTING:

MEDITATION

CHECK IN: (40 - 50 minutes)

What you share may be about your physical or spiritual health, cares or concerns for loved ones, issues you are facing.

Each person in the group speaks uninterrupted, for five minutes each, if there is time remaining, additional sharing and responses are welcome.

FOCUS: "MY RELATIONSHIP/BELIEF ABOUT GOD OR A POWER BEYOND MYSELF"

"The idea that God is an oversized white male with a flowing beard, who sits in the sky and tallies the fall of every sparrow is ludicrous. But if by 'God,' one means the set of physical laws that govern the universe, then clearly there is such a God. Discussion questions:

How has your engagement with the question of God changed over your life? Do you have a belief about God or a higher power which sustains you? What is it? What beliefs do motivate or sustain you?

If you don't believe in a God who possesses human qualities like love and who embodies justice and mercy, do you think that there is anything out there at all that inspires those qualities in us? To What should we pay attention?

LIKES AND WISHES

How did this session go for you? Is there anything you'd like to call particular attention to?
